VISION OF THE CYBERSCHOOL

The Central City Cyberschool of Milwaukee is a public, charter, elementary school located in and designed to serve residents of Milwaukee's urban center. In 2016, the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction's Report Card rated the Cyberschool in the "Exceeds Expectations" category of K-8 schools, and the City of Milwaukee's Charter School Review Committee's annual report of the Cyberschool placed it in the "Exemplary/High Performing" category.

The Cyberschool opened a newly-constructed, state-of-the-art building to educate 400 students in grades K through eight (K-8) in the fall of 2000. The Cyberschool is a student-centered learning environment where teamwork is promoted and high expectations are held out for each student, teacher, parent, staff member, community member and partner. Every staff member and student is provided with access to a laptop computer and the Internet.

The mission of the Central City Cyberschool of Milwaukee is *to motivate in each child from Milwaukee's central city the love of learning, the academic, social and leadership skills necessary to engage in critical thinking, and the ability to demonstrate mastery of the academic skills necessary for a successful future.*

RESPONSIBILITIES

One of a team of four Kindergarten teachers within our K-8 school, including a K4 ELA teacher, K4 Math teacher, K5 ELA teacher, and K5 Math teacher. Prepare children for their future academic lives by promoting their mental, physical, and social development. Help children develop critical thinking skills. Organize lessons in a way that keeps children active and alert. The English Language Arts curriculum allows students to develop critical thinking and comprehension abilities while learning to love quality literature. Teacher is responsible for designing a classroom-based assessment system that informs instructional focus areas, meets students' needs, monitors understanding, and evaluates growth in students' abilities to read and respond to text. Success with Daily Five, Lucy Calkins Writing Curriculum, and Open Court Reading preferred.

QUALIFICATIONS

Wisconsin teacher certification license required OR eligibility for emergency permit required. Minimum two years experience and demonstrated success with urban students preferred. Willingness to develop professionally and to play a leading role in promoting the Cyberschool's mission required.
